

PROTECT OUR GREEN BELT IN KINGS LANGLEY

To the House of Commons,
The petition of residents of the Parish of Kings Langley in the Borough of Dacorum

Declares that Dacorum Borough Council should avoid development on the green belt in Kings Langley; further that Hertfordshire County Council should immediately state they are not willing to see Wayside Farm developed for housing as they are the land owners; further that the local Parish Council and local residents are against the loss of its precious and much valued green belt if development is permitted and further that action should be taken to prioritise development on suitable brownfield sites to protect our green space.

We call upon Parliament to fully support measures to stop development on green belt land and to prevent de-designation of green belt land, to halt the coalescence of villages such as Kings Langley into neighbouring towns thus permanently losing their character.
